**Entry Fee:** \$100.00 (Non-Refundable)

**Port-A-Can Rentals:** \$75.00 (Must be ordered 1 week before cook-off)

**Each team will receive 5 armbands good for Admission.**

**(Kids 6 and under are free)**

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**CATEGORIES**

- **Best 'Rita' (Judging starts at 8:30pm Friday)** is awarded to the top 3 teams that make the best margarita, frozen or on the rocks. Three lucky judges will come to each team and judge this category. Each team will present their entry to the Judges. This category will be judged on taste only.
- **Beef Fajitas - 8:00pm Friday**  
(No onions, or peppers, **Fajita meat only**) The fajitas can be pre-seasoned prior to the cook-off.
- **Ladies Choice: (Judging starts at 11:30am Saturday)**  
This category consists of any dish you wish to cook. It has to be prepared in one pot (e.g., beans, chili, stew, soup, gumbo, ice cream, etc.), and prepared by **Females Only**.  
Condiments (e.g., cheese, ketchup, salsa, etc.) may be served along side of your main dish, and may be used at the Judges discretion.  
The Judging will be done by females only. Three (3) Judges will come to each camp, and the dish must be served by you. Considerations will be given not only for the taste of the entry, but for creativeness, hospitality, and presentation.  
**(Only one dish may be served, this is not a 3 course meal.)**
- **Pork Loin - 2:30pm Saturday**
- **Chicken - 3:00pm Saturday**  
All entries in this category shall be a half of a chicken, and enough bite size pieces for 6 Judges
- **Pork Ribs - 3:30pm Saturday**
- **Beef Brisket - 4:00pm Saturday**

All entries turned in must contain enough meat to serve at least 6 Judges.

The **Overall scores** are determined by the accumulative scores of the following categories. **Beef Fajitas, Pork Loin, Chicken, Pork Ribs, and Beef Brisket.** The awards presentation will start during the auction on the secondary stage.

**Meat Inspection:**

All meats will be inspected prior to cooking. No seasoned or marinated meats will be allowed prior to inspection. (Except for Beef Fajitas) All meats will be inspected at one time.

**Garnish:**

No garnish will be allowed in any of the containers turned in for judging. This prohibits any toothpicks, foil wrappings, pieces of fruit or vegetables, or any other "foreign" substances that is not in the category being judged. Such garnishments will result in the entry being disqualified, which has happened in the past for sauces and foil. **(This does not apply for Ladies Choice.)**

**Sauces:**

No sauces should be added to any entries. Sauces may be used as a "mop" during cooking, but not poured on for presentation. **(This does not apply for Ladies Choice.)**

The cook-off entries must be received at the judging area by members of the stage committee. No marks will be placed on the entries at this time. No entries will be accepted after the deadline has passed. The entries shall be removed one at a time and given a consecutive numerical number by a member of the stage committee. At this time, the entries will be examined for any garnishments or sauces that will disqualify them.

**Appeals:**

Any appeals to the above procedures shall be decided by the Cook-off Chairman who will be present on the stage during the judging. His decision will be final for the Needville Harvest Festival

### RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. The cook-off will be located on the baseball field parking lot. Teams will be provided with one approximate 40' x 40' space. **This year all teams will be assigned a space. The teams that participated in the Cook-off the previous year will maintain their same space if they want. These spaces will be reserved until September 10th. After this date, any unclaimed space will be re-assigned to other teams. (This means that returning teams that want to participate in this years cook-off must send in an entry form or call and reserve your space before 9-10-10. If you are a new team wanting to participate, you may call and get on a waiting list before 9-10-10. After this date, we will add new teams from the waiting list.** Due to limited space, only the first forty (40) entries received will be allowed in the cook-off. (See the enclosed map for cook-off layout & 2009 contestants.)
2. **Teams are not allowed to sell any merchandise or barbecue to the public.** If you wish to sell merchandise, you must purchase a Vendor Booth from the Harvest Festival.
3. Props, trailers, motor homes, tents, or any other part of the team's equipment must not exceed the boundaries of their respective cook-off space. Vehicles will not remain within the cook-off area.
4. Contestants must supply all needed equipment and supplies. Electricity and water are not provided. The type of cooking devices is not restricted. No dug fire pits or holes will be allowed. All fires must be contained.
5. Each chief cook is responsible for having his/her entry at the designated area at the designated time. We will not accept late entries.
6. Cook-off Committee reserves the right to make any additional regulations as situations warrant. Decisions of the committee and judges are final. Cook-off Committee Chairman has final say on all matters and decisions pertaining to the cook-off.
7. Cook-off site tear down will not be allowed until 6:00 am Sunday (weather permitting). There will be no movement of vehicles into the cook-off area until that time.
8. The chief cook will be responsible for the conduct of their team and guest. Fighting will not be tolerated, and will be grounds for automatic disqualification.
9. **At no time may any person under the age of 21 be served alcohol.** Teams found to be serving minors or teams not protecting access to alcohol by a minor may face legal action under Texas Alcohol Beverage Code, and may be disqualified. Excessive use of alcoholic beverages and/or any misconduct may be grounds for disqualification.
10. Amplification should be used in moderation and must be turned off at midnight. Speakers should be aimed toward your designated area, not outward, or toward any other adjacent teams.
